Catholic and Evangelical Prayer Plan for the State of Ohio in Response to the Anti-Life, Anti-Parent Abortion Amendment

VOTE NO IN NOVEMBER

"If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, pray, seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land." 2 Chronicles 7:14

Daily 7:14 Prayer: Every day at 7:14 a.m. and 7:14 p.m., in the spirit of 2 Chronicles 7:14, we pause as a state to thank God for the gift of life, to pray for protection for the preborn, their mothers and fathers and we pray earnestly for the defeat of this anti-life amendment in November.

Weekly Holy Hour of Prayer: Each week, we invite individuals, pastors and prayer leaders to a Holy Hour of prayer, outside of Sunday, to set aside time to pray, to repent of our sins and ask the Lord's merciful and powerful hand to bring us victory in November. Coalition groups can take turns leading a Zoom Meeting every Friday at 3 p.m. beginning Friday, September 22nd. These seven prayer meetings before the election could have unique prayer points:

- For financial blessings for our campaign.
- For our coalition, strategists and volunteers.
- For priests, pastors and deacons to preach and teach zealously for the defeat of the amendment.
- For the convincing of the electorate to vote no in November.
- For the conversion of the pro-abortion forces pushing for this amendment.
- For the media to fairly and accurately cover the dangers of the amendment.
- For the salvation of souls and the protection of the preborn in our state.

Fasting: Individuals, families and churches are challenged to take on the discipline of fasting for repentance of our personal and collective sins, including the sin of abortion. Coinciding with the 40 Days for Life Campaign (<u>40daysforlife.com</u>) we will fast for 40 Days September 27th through November 5th. Why fast?

- As imitators of God, Jesus Christ, we fast because he fasted. Matthew 4:2
- Jesus expects us, as his disciples, to fast as well. Matthew 6:16-18
- We can fast to ask for God's intervention. 2 Samuel 12:15-17
- Some demons can only be cast out by prayer and fasting. Mark 9:29

In particular, we would like individuals to consider fasting and offering sacrifice in three unique ways during these 40 Days between September 27th through November 5th if they are capable:

- Embracing daily cold showers.
- Forgoing snacks between meals.
- Intentionally replacing 'screen time' with the Word of God.
